## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REQUIRE COMPANY TO PRESERVE METER

Issue Date: June 19, 2014 Effective Date: June 19, 2014

Gene Koverman filed a complaint against Missouri American Water Company alleging that the company billed him incorrectly as a result of a broken water meter. The meter has been replaced.

The Staff of the Commission now requests that the company be ordered to preserve the replaced meter because the condition of the meter is central to Staff's investigation. Staff requests expedited treatment of its motion.

Unless otherwise ordered, Commission rule<sup>1</sup> allows a 10-day response time to pleadings. The Commission finds that no benefit would enure by allowing the company to respond to the motion. The Commission will therefore grant Staff's request. However, the motion assumes that the company still has the meter in question. Therefore, the Commission will direct the company to file a statement informing the Commission of whether it has the meter and if not on what date the company sent the meter to salvage.
