## ORDER REGARDING HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL DESIGNATION

Issue Date: April 22, 2010

Effective Date: April 22, 2010

The Commission is granting Mr. Dzurinskiy's motion to remove the highly confidential designation from documents ("motion"). Mr. Dzurinskiy included the motion filed in his April 5, 2010, response to the *Staff Investigation and Recommendation* ("recommendation"). On April 16, 2010, the Commission's Staff and MAWC filed their respective responses to the motions.

Mr. Dzurinskiy alleges inaccurate metering and billing in the complaint. The complaint and recommendation include matters related to Mr. Dzurinskiy's account. Such matters are subject to protection under the Commission's regulations:

(1) The commission recognizes . . . information that should not be made public.

\* \* \*

(B) Highly confidential information is information concerning:

1. Material or documents that contain information relating directly to specific customers; [and]

\* \* \*

5. Reports, work papers, or other documentation related to work produced by internal or external auditors or consultants [.]

\* \* \*

(4) Highly confidential information may be disclosed only to the attorneys of record, or to outside experts that have been retained for the purpose of the case. [<sup>1</sup>]

But the only matters designated as highly confidential relate to the account of Mr. Dzurinskiy, the party seeking the removal of such protection.

Both MAWC and Staff state that they have no objection to Mr. Dzurinskiy's motion to make his own account information public, so the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion to remove the highly confidential designation from documents is granted.

2. The Commission's data center is directed to change the designation of all documents designated "HC" to "NP."

3. This order is effective when issued.
