Enclosed for filing with the Commission are an original and three copies of revised tariff sheets that include rate and language changes reflected in an <u>Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request</u> (Disposition Agreement) between the Timber Creek Sewer Company (Company) and the Commission Staff (Staff) regarding the above-referenced small company rate increase request. The Company submitted the referenced rate increase request on July 15, 2003, under the provisions of the Commission's small company rate increase procedure, and the request was assigned the above-referenced tracking number.

Additionally, please be advised that it is my understanding that the Staff will be filing the above-referenced Disposition Agreement with the Commission, once a formal rate case has been established pursuant to this tariff filing.

Consistent with the Disposition Agreement, the enclosed revised tariff sheets contain customer rates that are intended to produce an increase of \$80,000 in the Company's annual sewer system operating revenues, contain a revised contribution-in-aid-of-construction connection charge and contain new special service charges. The Disposition Agreement also calls for the Commission's approval of a schedule of depreciation rates for the Company, and contains provisions related to certain changes that will occur in the Company's business operations.

Since the Disposition Agreement is only between the Company and Staff, the enclosed tariff sheets bear an effective date that is more than 45 days from the issue date, as is required by the small company rate increase procedure. As is discussed in the Disposition Agreement, the Company will not be sending a notice to its customers regarding the terms of the agreement, as is required by the small company rate increase procedure, because of an anticipated request by the Office of the Public Counsel for a local public hearing. Rather, the Company will send one notice to its customers regarding both the Disposition Agreement and the local public hearing. If a local public hearing is not

held, the Company will send a notice regarding the terms of the Disposition Agreement to its customers. In either event, the Company will provide a copy of the customer notice to you for placement in the case file when it is mailed to the customers.

Late Charge *

Billings will be made and distributed at monthly intervals. Bills will be rendered net, bearing the last date on which payment will then be considered delinquent. The period after which the payment is considered delinquent is 21 days after rendition of the bill. A charge of 10% times the unpaid balance will be added to delinquent amounts.

Bad Check Charge *
