Order Scheduling Hearing

The Missouri Public Service Commission is scheduling a hearing on the complaint. On April 28, 2009, Rob Lee filed a "Motion to Set Date" stating that he, counsel for Missouri American Water Company, and counsel for the Commission's staff "have agreed on June 9 and 10, 2009, as acceptable dates for the hearing." Such representation constitutes good cause, to waive¹ the regulatory ten day period for responding to a motion,² and to grant the motion. The parties may continue their attempts to resolve disputed matters.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The regulatory law judge assigned to this case shall convene a hearing on the complaint in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri at 9:00 a.m., on June 9, 2009, and continuing as needed through June 10, 2009.
2. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to



participate in the pre-hearing conference shall alert the Public Service Commission before the hearing by calling the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711.

3. Any party presenting testimony by telephone at the hearing shall file a motion to do so no later than seven days before the hearing.

4. This order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
