ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On July 8, 2009, the City of O'Fallon, Missouri filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Missouri-American Water Company and Public Water Supply District No. 2 of St. Charles County, Missouri. The Staff of the Commission has filed its recommendation to which the District has responded.

This matter is now at issue and a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure its prompt resolution. At the prehearing conference, the parties or their representatives should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. The parties or their representatives should also be prepared to discuss the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions. The Commission will afford the parties an opportunity to participate in this hearing by telephone by calling the presiding judge at 573-751-8518 at least two days prior to the hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on October 19, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
