ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

National Water and Power Services Corporation ("NWPSC") requests an extension of time to cure deficiencies with its answer to Staff's complaint. The Commission finds NWPSC's request reasonable and will grant it. The Commission directs NWPSC not only to ensure its compliance with the Missouri Supreme Court's rules on appearing *pro hac vice*, but suggests NWPSC give close scrutiny to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040.

Public Service Commission's complaint be deemed admitted.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
