On May 25, 2010, local counsel for National Water & Power Services Corp., and co-respondent National Water & Power, Inc., Mr. Craig S. Johnson, filed a motion to withdraw.¹ Mr. Johnson states that National Water has failed to pay him for his services, and; consequently, he seeks to withdraw as local counsel.
