**ORDER DENYING REHEARING**

Issue Date: October 18, 2012

Effective Date: October 20, 2012

The Missouri Public Service Commission is denying the *Motion for Order to Take Judicial Notice*<sup>1</sup> ("motion"). The Commission is determining the motion under the standard for an application for rehearing<sup>2</sup> because that is the statutory procedure for the relief sought in the motion: a ruling different from that made in the *Report and Order*.<sup>3</sup> The Commission grants an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear."<sup>4</sup> The motion renews requests for relief already denied, which does not show
