## NOTICE CLOSING CASE

Date Issued: February 10, 2010

City of O'Fallon, Missouri filed a complaint against Missouri-American Water Company and Public Water Supply District No. 2 of St. Charles County, Missouri. To move the matter forward, the Commission set a prehearing conference. At the parties' request, the Commission cancelled the prehearing on October 19, 2009. Since that date, no action had taken place and the Commission directed the parties to file a status update. In response, City of O'Fallon filed a motion to dismiss its complaint.

Under Commission rule,<sup>1</sup> O'Fallon may dismiss its complaint, by filing a Notice of Dismissal, without an order of the Commission if no testimony has been prefiled or offered at hearing. There has been no testimony prefiled or offered at hearing. O'Fallon, however, has filed a Motion to Dismiss the Complaint rather than a Notice of Dismissal. The
