ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is allowing any party to show cause why the Commission should not set this case for hearing based on Staff's second status report.

Staff's first status report stated that the parties had reached an agreement in principle, so the Commission ordered a second status report on November 15, 2010, or earlier. Staff filed its second status report on July 26, 2010, stating that the agreement has not worked out. Staff asks the Commission to set a hearing date before November 15, 2010.

Therefore, the Commission will allow any party to show cause why the Commission should not set this case for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party may show cause why the Commission should not set this case for hearing by filing a response to this order, setting forth such cause, no later than August 12, 2010.
