

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1 **2. DIRECT TESTIMONY OF MS. LAURA WOLFE, MISSOURI**
2 **DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, ENERGY CENTER ON**
3 **ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS**

4 Q. What direct testimony was submitted by Missouri Department of Natural
5 Resources, Energy Center (EC) Witness, Ms. Laura Wolfe regarding EDG revenue
6 collections and expenditures on EE Programs?

7 A. Ms. Wolfe submitted direct testimony for both Revenue Requirement and
8 Rate Design which I will address together. In both of her direct testimonies, she proposes
9 that EDG continue to expend the funds for EE Programs proposed by EDG Witness Ms.
10 Sherill L. McCormack in her direct testimony for 2010 of approximately \$217,000 for
11 Residential, Small Commercial, and Large Commercial customers, but the funding
12 increase to approximately \$327,000 in the year 2011 and further increase to
13 approximately \$655,000 by 2012. She also supported Ms. McCormack's proposal for the
14 establishment of an EEC as an advisory group consisting of EDG and member
15 organizations of the Staff of the PSC, Office of the Public Counsel, and EC.

16 Q. What is your response to the direct testimonies of EC Witness Ms. Wolfe
17 regarding EDG EE Programs?

18 A. In her direct testimonies, Ms. Wolfe addressed EDG's expenditures on EE
19 Programs and proposed provisions for EDG EE programs going forward.

20 I recommend that EDG EE Programs continue to be funded and implemented as
21 proposed by Ms. Sherill L. McCormack in her direct testimony as described above, and
22 as agreed to in the PARTIAL STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT ON DSM
23 FUNDING. Any additional funding or change in the funding mechanism for either

1 Residential EE programs or Small Commercial EE programs should be contingent on the
2 success of the current programs. The EEC should be a non-binding advisory group.

3 The funding levels proposed by Ms. McCormack are based on a current Applied
4 Energy Group (AEG) study of the EDG service area. The funding levels proposed by
5 Ms. Wolfe are based on a general multi-state study in 2006 conducted by American
6 Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy (ACEEE). The more current and focused
7 AEG study should be relied on more than the ACEEE study.

8 3. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

9 Q. What is your recommendation regarding the direct testimonies of EC
10 Witness Ms. Wolfe regarding the funding for EE Programs and the EEC?

11 A. My recommendation is EDG should fund the EE Programs for the
12 Residential, and Commercial customers as proposed by Ms. McCormack. Staff agrees
13 that the EEC should be established as a non-binding advisory group.

14 Q. Why do you recommend a non-binding advisory group?

15 A. So that decisions about the EE programs ultimately are Company
16 decisions, and Staff, or any other stakeholder, does not directly determine the expenditure
17 of funds by the Company outside of a case.

18 Q. Does this conclude your rebuttal testimony?

19 A. Yes, it does.
