It appears that in 2007 there were 12,408,753 1000 gallon units of water missing in action. If my arithmetic is right that is 12,408,753,000 gallons of water that is unaccounted for in this water system. That is twelve Billion gallons of water. Where did it go. I never see it so I assume most of it is pumped under ground. No wonder Staff thinks there are springs in north county.
