ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO FILE AN ANSWER

On June 27, 2006, Susan D. Jaeger filed a complaint against Mr. Joe Hybl. On June 30, 2006, the Commission issued a Notice of Complaint to Mr. Hybl informing him that he had until July 30, 2006, in which to file an answer to the complaint. On August 2, 2006, the Commission received a memo from Mr. Hybl requesting an extension of time in which to file his answer.

Mr. Hybl's memo implies that he failed to respond to the Notice of Complaint in a timely manner because he was out of town and only recently received notice of the Complaint. The Commission shall, therefore, grant Mr. Hybl's request for an extension.

Mr. Hybl does not state how much time he needs to file his answer, nor does he serve his correspondence upon the Complainant. The Commission will therefore limit his extension as set out below. Mr. Hybl is cautioned that any future correspondence or pleadings filed in the official case file must also be sent to the Complainant. And, in

accordance with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(18), copies of any filings should also be sent to the General Counsel of the Commission, and to the Office of the Public Counsel.

The Commission will also extend the time for the filing of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's investigation report and any responses to that report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The request for an extension of time in which to file an answer is granted.
- 2. No later than August 18, 2006, Mr. Hybl shall file his answer to the Complaint.
- 3. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its investigation report and recommendation no later than August 23, 2006.
- 4. Any responses to the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's investigation report and recommendation shall be filed no later than September 5, 2006.
 - 5. This order shall become effective on August 3, 2006.
