Those attending the meeting for Ameren Missouri included: President and CEO Warner Baxter, Vice President of Regulatory and Legislative Affairs Warren Wood, Director and Assistant General Counsel Tom Byrne and State Regulatory Liaison Gaye Suggett.

Those attending from the Missouri Public Service Commission included: Chairman Robert Kenney and Commission Advisor Goldie Tompkin.

Warner Baxter thanked the Chairman for his time. He said April and May were busy times for storm activity with three major events. He said we continue to learn from each event, and continue to improve our communications. Social media has proven to be a useful tool.

Mr. Wood gave an update on Ameren Missouri's newest energy efficiency programs which began January 2, 2013. He said we have worked with customers to save over 100,000 MWh of energy through June 2013, and have created \$35M in Net Shared Benefits. He gave everyone a copy of a brochure that customers receive.

Mr. Baxter said the President's recent push on climate continues to impact the Midwest, and the policies shaped over the next 5 to 6 years will be very important.

Mr. Baxter said Westinghouse submitted the application for the next round of funding for Small Modular Reactors (SMRs). Ameren Missouri and the Missouri Electric Alliance continue to work with Westinghouse. A decision is expected this fall.

Mr. Baxter said he appreciated the time and effort the PSC spent working on information regarding aging infrastructure.

The Chairman said his priorities are to litigate cases with excellence and integrity, and to have an effective communication and media plan.
