ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONTINUE AND DIRECTING FILING

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion to Continue* (“motion”). Staff filed the motion on October 24, 2011, alleging that the business for which service is at issue may, despite the understanding of Eric C. Larson to the contrary, be the property of a limited liability company. Staff asks that the Commission continue the evidentiary hearing to ensure compliance with the law governing legal representation. Such is the Commission’s duty.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion to Continue* is granted and the hearing scheduled for November 7 and 8, 2011, is cancelled.
2. No later than January 24, 2012, Staff shall file a status report on ownership of the business for which service is at issue.
