ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The City of Houston Lake, Missouri ("Houston Lake") filed a complaint against Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), and against the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"). The Commission dismissed itself as a party, so that only the complaint against MAWC remains. MAWC answered.
