# ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE ANOTHER ASSESSMENT

Issue Date: January 23, 2017 Effective Date: January 23, 2017

On January 20, 2017, the Commission's Staff filed a complaint against Ridge Creek Water Company, LLC, Ridge Creek Development, LLC, and Michael Stoner and Denise Stoner, alleging that the Respondents are failing to provide safe and adequate water service to their customers. Along with its complaint, Staff filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment and Injunction that asks the Commission to direct its General Counsel to proceed to Circuit Court to seek a preliminary and permanent injunction requiring the Respondents to take the necessary action to provide safe and adequate service to its customers by fixing a service main needed to provide water to a customer. Staff asked the Commission to act as soon as possible.

At the Commission's direction, Staff filed an updated assessment of the situation on January 23. So that the Commission can be kept apprised of the situation, it will direct

Staff to file an updated assessment on January 24. The Respondents may file their own response, or may provide information to Staff for inclusion in Staff's assessment.

# THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Staff shall file a pleading no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 24, 2017, describing its updated assessment of the provision of water by Ridge Creek Water Company.
- 2. The Respondents may file their own pleading describing their assessment of the provision of water by Ridge Creek Water Company by 5:00 p.m. on January 24, 2017, or may provide that information to Staff for inclusion in Staff's pleading.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
