ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

On October 12, 2006,¹ the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order approving Missouri-American Water Company's ("MAWC") infrastructure system replacement surcharge (ISRS), but rejecting MAWC's originally-proposed tariff to implement the ISRS. In that same order, the Commission authorized MAWC to file a new tariff recovering the revenue and implementing the rates, authorized in the order approving the ISRS. On October 13, Missouri-American Water Company submitted a revised tariff sheet intended to be in compliance with the Commission's October 12 order. Although the tariff sheet has an effective date of November 13, the company requests that the Commission approve the tariff to become effective by October 23.

On October 17, the Staff of the Commission filed a pleading advising the Commission that the proposed tariff is in compliance with the Commission's order and recommending that the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on October 23. Having reviewed the pleadings in this matter and finding that the tariff is in

compliance with the Commission's order, and that good cause exists to approve the tariff in less than 30 days, the Commission will approve the proposed tariff.
