ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On January 29, 2008, Missouri-American Water Company filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1000, 393.1003, and 393.1006, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2007, requesting that the Commission authorize it to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge. Section 393.1006.2(3) requires that the Commission act on the application no later than 120 days after it was filed. That means that the Commission must issue an order regarding the application with an effective date no later than May 28, 2008.

Along with its application, MAWC filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge. Unless the Commission suspends that tariff, it will become effective on February 28, 2008.

So that it can consider MAWC's implementing tariff and the underlying application, that tariff shall be suspended until May 28, 2008, unless sooner approved or rejected by the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed by Missouri-American Water Company, on January 29, 2008, and assigned tariff number JW-2008-0450, is suspended until May 28, 2008. The tariff suspended is:

6th REVISED SHEET NO. RT 18.0, CANCELLING 5th REVISED SHEET No. RT 18.0

2. The order shall become effective on February 1, 2008.
