**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING INTERVENTION DATE**

On April 21, 2009, Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1000, 393.1003 and 393.1006, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2008; and 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) and 4 CSR 240-3.650, requesting adjustment to its rates and charges through a change to its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") rate schedule to provide recovery of costs for infrastructure system replacement and relocations eligible for ISRS recognition. Section 393.1006.2(3) requires the Commission to act on Missouri American's application no later 120 days after it was filed. Consequently, the Commission must issue a report and order regarding the petition effective no later than August 19, 2009. With its application, Missouri-American filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge. Unless the Commission acts to suspend that tariff, it will become effective on May 21, 2009.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> The Commission will address the potential tariff suspension in a separate order.

Section 393.1006.1(2) requires that the Commission publish notice of MAWC's filing. Therefore, notice of this application should be made to the general public and those who may be interested, and a date set for intervention requests.

The Commission will require that its Data Center mail a copy of this notice to the St. Louis County Commission and to the parties in MAWC's last general rate case. Also, the Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving St. Louis County and to the members of the General Assembly representing St. Louis County.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve notice as set out in the body of this order.
2. The Information Officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve notice as set out in the body of this order.
