ORDER CORRECTING ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

Issue Date: August 10, 2011

Effective Date: August 20, 2011

On April 6, 2011, Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, LLC d/b/a Liberty Water ("Liberty Water") and Noel Water Co., Inc. ("Noel") submitted an Application to the Commission.¹ Liberty Water wants to purchase substantially all of Noel's assets.

The Commission gave notice, and allowed until May 3, 2011 for interested persons to request intervention. The Commission received no requests to intervene.

On August 10, the Commission issued its Order Approving Joint Application. That order contains an error, which the Commission hereby corrects *nunc pro tunc*.

Ordered paragraph sixteen of the Order Approving Joint Application refers to Liberty Water giving at least forty-five days notice prior to the anticipated closure of its local office. This is the language used in the Staff Recommendation filed on July 25. However, Staff filed an Amended Recommendation on August 4, stating that Liberty Water would give at least forty-five days notice prior to any anticipated closure of its local office. This is the language to which the Office of Public Counsel and Liberty

Water had no objection, and the language that the Commission intended to use in ordered paragraph sixteen.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The August 10, 2011 Order Approving Joint Application is corrected *nunc pro tunc* as described above.
2. This order shall become effective on August 20, 2011.
3. This file shall be closed on August 21, 2011.
