Indian Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. filed an application to acquire certain assets of I.H. Utilities, Inc. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission has filed a recommendation to conditionally approve the application.

Section 390.190.1 requires that when transactions such as the one described in the application are submitted to the Commission for approval, the Commission must send notice to the county clerk of each county in which any portion of a political subdivision which will be affected by such disposition is located. Since the application states that the water facilities being transferred are located in Crawford County, the Commission will direct the Data Center of the Commission to send a copy of this order to the county clerk and county commission of Crawford County, Missouri.

Anyone wishing to intervene may do so by filing an application with the Commission as ordered below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center for the Commission shall send a copy of this order to the county clerk and county commission of Crawford County, Missouri
2. Applications to intervene shall be filed with the Commission no later than January 14, 2016.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
