ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 2, 2021, the Commission ordered a procedural schedule in which the parties' post hearing initial briefs are due February 14, 2022 and reply briefs are due February 22, 2022. A hearing was held January 20 and 21, 2022. The hearing transcript was filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) the afternoon of February 8, 2022.

On February 9, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Motion for Enlargement of Time to File Post Hearing Briefs*, requesting that the procedural schedule be amended so that initial briefs are due by February 18, 2022, and reply briefs are due by February 28, 2022. The other parties in this matter do not oppose the motion.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule, issued and effective on November 2, 2021, is hereby amended as follows:

Initial Briefs	-	February 18, 2022
Reply Briefs	-	February 28, 2022
