ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On April 26, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed applications to purchase and operate a water and sewer system in and around the City of Eureka, in St. Louis County, Missouri.

On May 4, 2021, Jefferson County Public Sewer District (The District) timely filed an application to intervene. The District stated that it is a reorganized common sewer district and political subdivision. The District stated its interests are different than those of the general public in that it provides water and sewer services in and around the City of Eureka, including portions of the proposed service areas.

More than ten days have passed since the application to intervene was filed and no one has responded. After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that The District has interests which are different from that of the general public and that may be affected by a final order arising from this file. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application of The District to intervene is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
