COMPLAINANTS' AND INTERVENERS' REQUEST FOR HEARING IN RESPONSE TO ORDER ADOPTING ANCILLARY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW, the following Complainants and Interveners in the above referenced cases, being represented by their individual signatures below, to request a hearing on March 30, 2007.

1. On March 07, 2007, the Commission issued the "Order Adopting Ancillary Procedural Schedule." As stated in the Commission's Order, leave was

granted to the Respondents to supply additional testimony on the nature of the service line installations.

- 2. The Respondents were granted before hearing adjournment on Friday, March 02, 2007, a request for leave to file the additional testimony of specifically, Mr. Kenneth Carroll, contractor, pertaining to the bedding material used for the service line installations of the water and sewer system on Big Island. Based on that information, Complainants and Interveners had no objections to this request.
- 3. However, on March 12, 2007, the testimony filed by the Respondents in this matter, was filed by Mr. James T Crowder, and not the contractor responsible for the installation, Mr. Kenneth Carroll. Additionally, no testimony was provided by Mr. Crowder, as to the bedding material used for the service line installations of the water and sewer system on Big Island. Furthermore, most of the testimony provided by Mr. Crowder, is pertaining to the flexible piping used for the installation, and not pertaining to the installation process itself. Since the warranty of the pipe, is a "...limited warranty and is not applicable in the event of installation and/or use of the Pipe by the holder of the Limited Warranty or any third party which is not in accordance with the specifications for installation and use of the Pipe, and is not applicable with respect to any failure in performance of the Pipe which is due in whole or in part to any reason other than a defect in materials or workmanship..." (Crowder Direct Schedule 2); the warranted integrity of the Pipe, is only as good as it's installation. Mr. Crowder did not include as a part of his testimony, a Crowder Direct Schedule of the specifications for installation and use of the Pipe.

4. Moreover, the water and sewer system on Big Island, has a documented history of incorrect installation practices by Folsom Ridge.

Wherefore, the Complainants and Interveners, hereby make the request for a hearing on March 30, 2007, and ask that Mr. James T. Crowder and Mr. Kenneth Carroll provide testimony at that hearing.
