ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 15, 2022, Foxfire Utility Company (Foxfire) filed its application in this matter and Ozark Clean Water Company (Ozark) was joined as a party on April 8. On August 9, the Commission conducted a procedural conference, and on August 10, Foxfire and Ozark, along with the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a joint proposed procedural schedule.

After reviewing the jointly proposed procedural schedule, the Commission concludes that the schedule proposed by the parties is reasonable and should be adopted.

The Commission will adopt the following procedural schedule.

- 2. The parties shall comply with the following procedural requirements:
 - (a) Testimony shall be pre-filed as defined in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.130, including the requirement that testimony be filed on line-numbered pages. After the filing of Direct Testimony, the Parties shall have five (5) business days to object to any data request and ten (10) calendar days to respond. However, data requests served after noon on a Friday will be treated as if served the next business day. Also, if a deadline falls on a weekend or a holiday, the due date will be the next business day thereafter.
 - (b) Although not all parties may agree upon how each issue should be described or on whether a listed issue is in fact a proper issue in this case, the parties shall agree upon and file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear, the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue that must be resolved.
 - (c) Each party shall file a simple and concise statement summarizing its position on each disputed issue. Position statements shall track the list of issues.
 - (d) All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

- (e) If testimony or documents are prefiled and served upon the parties before a hearing, a party need only provide an emailed copy of the testimony or document to exhibits@psc.mo.gov. If not prefiled and served upon the parties, then a party who has a document marked for use at the hearing shall email it to the presiding officer, and counsel for each other party, prior to the hearing if possible.
- 3. The hearing shall be held on October 24 through 25, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
