Dear Secretary Woodruff:

On behalf of Spire Missouri Inc. (the "Company"), enclosed herewith for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission are the Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR) tariff sheets, P.S.C. MO. No. 7, Sixth Revised Sheet No. 13.2 of the eastern Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire ("Spire East") and P.S.C. MO. No. 8, Sixth Revised Sheet No. 13.2 of the western Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire ("Spire West").

These revised tariff sheets, have an issue date of September 1, 2021 and an effective date of October 1, 2021. The Weather Normalization Adjustment (WNA) for Spire East is \$0.00381 per therm and the WNA for Spire West is \$0.00820 per Ccf of gas used. These rates are calculated semiannually to adjust for actual heating degree days as they differ from the normal levels and are effective for six (6) months.

For the average Spire East residential customer, this filing represents a charge of 26 cents per month, which is equal to a decrease of about 0.64% per month from existing rates. For the average Spire West residential customer, the WNAR represents a charge of 51 cents per month, or a decrease of about 0.25% per month from existing rates. Such bill impacts may be less or more depending on a customer's actual usage, which is primarily affected by weather.
