ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S THIRD MOTION TO EXTEND
DEADLINE TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On February 24, 2005, Missouri-American Water Company applied for authority to build transmission mains and points of delivery to sell and deliver water to the City of Kirkwood. Missouri-American also filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of March 26, 2005.

On May 13, Staff filed its Third Motion to Extend Deadline to File Recommendation. Staff stated that the parties continue to negotiate, and noted that Missouri-American extended the tariff effective date to June 24. Staff asks the Commission to extend its deadline to file the Recommendation to June 10.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, finds it reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff's Third Motion to Extend Deadline to File Recommendation is granted.

2. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than June 10, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on May 16, 2005.
