This report covers the period of September 1, 2007 to September 30, 2007 and serves as the "monthly status report" for that period. Staff will continue to file these reports on or around the last working day of each month unless directed to do otherwise.

The Black Oak Mountain Resort Property Owners Association (Association) is satisfied with the condition of title to the water and sewer utility assets, and believes that it can acquire clear title to these assets, although they will be subject to a lease between it and Stone County until Neighborhood Improvement District bonds are paid.

The Association held its September Labor Day Weekend meeting on Saturday September 1, 2007, which was a general membership meeting. The membership, generally, was in favor of proceeding with acquisition of the utility property by the Association. The Association is now investigating details such as liability insurance for the utility board, and drafting proposed utility operating by-laws.
