On February 24, 2005, Missouri-American Water Company applied for authority to build transmission mains and points of delivery to sell and deliver water to the City of Kirkwood. Missouri-American also filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of March 26, 2005. Missouri-American later extended the tariff effective date to July 25.

On July 11, the Staff of the Commission filed its Recommendation. The Staff recommended that the Commission approve the contract between Missouri-American and Kirkwood, subject to certain cost overrun and accounting conditions.

The Commission will order Missouri-American to state whether it accepts Staff's Recommendation and its conditions.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Missouri-American Water Company shall respond to the Staff of the Commission's Recommendation, and state whether it accepts the Recommendation and its conditions, no later than July 15, 2005.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 12, 2005.
