ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND
DEADLINE TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On February 24, 2005, Missouri-American Water Company applied for authority to build transmission mains and points of delivery to sell and deliver water to the City of Kirkwood. Missouri-American also filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of March 26, 2005.

Missouri-American later extended its tariff effective date until April 25. The Commission granted Staff's motion for extension of time, and ordered Staff to file its Recommendation no later than April 11.

On April 13, Staff filed its Second Motion to Extend Deadline to File Recommendation. Staff stated that it had not had time to prepare its recommendation, and asked to file its recommendation no later than May 13. On April 14, Missouri-American extended its tariff effective date until May 25.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, finds it reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff's Second Motion to Extend Deadline to File Recommendation is granted.
2. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than May 13, 2005.
3. That this order shall become effective on April 15, 2005.
