ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On January 3, 2006, Missouri-American Water Company filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1000, 393.1003, and 393.1006, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2005, requesting that the Commission authorize it to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge. Section 393.1006.2(3) requires that the Commission act on Missouri-American's application no later than 120 days after it was filed. That means that the Commission must issue an order regarding the application no later than May 3, 2006. Along with its application, Missouri-American filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge. Unless the Commission acts to suspend that tariff, it will become effective on February 2, 2006.

So that it can consider Missouri-American's implementing tariff and the underlying application, that tariff shall be suspended until May 3, 2006, unless sooner approved by the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet filed by Missouri-American Water Company on January 3,

2006, and assigned tariff number YW-2006-0520, is suspended until May 3, 2006. The tariff suspended is:

P.S.C. MO. NO. 6 2nd Revised Sheet No. RT 18.0, Cancelling 1st Revised Sheet No. RT 18.0

2. That the order shall become effective on January 31, 2006.
