On July 25, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Hickory Hills Water & Sewer Co., Inc., filed a Unanimous Stipulation and Consent Order for Appointment of Interim Receiver and Order to General Counsel to Petition the Circuit Court of Cole County for the Appointment of a Receiver ("Unanimous Stipulation and Consent Order") with the Commission. On August 3, 2006, the Commission approved the Unanimous Stipulation and Consent Order", but did not find sufficient evidence in the record to determine what would constitute reasonable compensation for the interim receiver. To avoid unnecessarily delaying the appointment of the interim receiver, the Commission approved the stipulated agreement, but declined to make a determination on reasonable compensation. Instead the Commission ordered its Staff to submit a proposed compensation agreement for consideration, and stated that it would make a determination on this issue in a subsequent order.

The Staff and the interim receiver, Mr. Cover, filed a Proposed Compensation Agreement on September 25, 2006. The Office of the Public Counsel was not a signatory to that agreement. The Commission has questions regarding the Unanimous Stipulation and Consent Order and will schedule a proceeding at which it will address questions to the parties.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1.
