On April 1, 2013¹, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) asked that the Commission approve its agreement with the Chariton County Public Water Supply District (“District”). That agreement would allow Missouri-American to sell and deliver water to District. In addition, MAWC filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of May 1, 2013.

On April 25, the Staff of the Commission moved the Commission to suspend the tariff. Staff states that it will be able to file a Recommendation on May 13.

By separate order this date, the Commission suspended the tariff. The Commission will also order its Staff to file a Recommendation.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:
