On April 1, 2013<sup>1</sup>, Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") asked that the Commission approve its agreement with the Chariton County Public Water Supply District ("District"). That agreement would allow Missouri-American to sell and deliver water to District. In addition, MAWC filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of May 1, 2013.

The Commission issued notice on April 2, and AG Processing, Inc. filed a timely application to intervene. No party objected.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications the Commission finds that the applicant meets the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.
