**ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On September 2, 2014, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) filed a petition to approve a change to its infrastructure system replacement surcharge. On November 13, 2014, Staff filed a recommendation advising that the Commission approve the petition after making certain adjustments, to which MAWC objected. Staff filed a proposed procedural schedule on behalf of all the parties. The Commission will adopt the proposed procedural schedule with a modification. Since as of this date the parties are not sure whether there are material facts in dispute, the Commission will provide a choice of filings on November 24 depending on an agreement on this issue. The date of December 1 will be reserved for either an evidentiary hearing or oral arguments, depending on what filing the parties make on November 24.

1. The following procedural schedule is established:



An evidentiary hearing or oral arguments are scheduled for Monday, December 1, 2014, beginning at 8:30 a.m. The proceeding will be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
