NOTICE REGARDING CANCELLATION OF HEARING

Issue Date: June 27, 2006

On June 27, 2006, the Commission issued an order that suspended the procedural schedule, including the hearing and all discovery activity, until further order of the Commission. Later on June 27, after the Commission's order had been issued, a response from Cathy Orler, one of the complainants, was filed. That response suggested that proceedings in the complaint case be suspended only until the July 17 hearing, presumably meaning that the Respondents would be precluded from conducting any discovery before the hearing. That response also requests additional information about the application for certificate of convenience and necessity filed by Big Island Water and Sewer Company.

To avoid any ambiguity and confusion, the Commission will clarify that the order suspending the procedural schedule means that the hearing scheduled to begin on July 17

has been canceled. If necessary, it will be rescheduled by subsequent order of the Commission.

If Ms. Orler, or any of the other complainants, wish to challenge the application for a certificate of convenience and necessity filed by Big Island Water and Sewer Company, currently pending in Case No. WA-2006-0480, they will need to file an application to intervene in that case by July 10.

The Commission will also remind the parties that a pleading is not filed with the Commission until it is received by the Commission. That means that if a party plans to mail a pleading to the Commission, it must be mailed early enough to allow time for it to be delivered to the Commission by the date it must be filed.
