APPLICATION TO INTERVENE FOR CITY OF WARRENSBURG

Comes now the City of Warrensburg pursuant to 4CSR 240-2.075 and for its Application to Intervene states to the Commission:

1. The City of Warrensburg, Missouri, is a third class municipality situated in Johnson County, Missouri. The City Hall is located at 102 S. Holden, Warrensburg, Missouri 64093. The City receives water service from Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC").

3. On May 19, 2003, Missouri-American Water Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for water and sewer service provided to customers in the Missouri service area of the Company. The proposed tariffs bear a requested effective date of June 18, 2003. The proposed water service tariffs are designed to produce an annual increase of approximately 12.2 percent in the Company's revenues.

4. On May 29, 2003, the Commission issued its Suspension Order and Notice setting a date for interested parties to intervene no later than June 18, 2003.


5. The City of Warrensburg seeks to intervene in this rate case proceeding but at this time takes no position on any of the issues underlying the proposed rate increase.

6. The City of Warrensburg's interests are different from those of the general public.

WHEREFORE, the City of Warrensburg respectfully requests the Commission to grant its Application to Intervene.


