ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Effective Date: November 7, 2006

This order modifies the procedural schedule by revising the dates on which certain testimony shall be filed.

On October 23, 2006, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Dismiss the Application of Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, Inc. for a Rate Increase or, in the Alternative, to Modify the Procedural Schedule. Staff contends that Algonquin has been less than forthcoming in providing information to Staff for its review for the upcoming rate case hearing. Staff asks that the Commission dismiss the case or, in the alternative, modify the procedural schedule to give Staff more time to respond to Algonquin.

On November 1, Algonquin responded. Algonquin admitted Staff's assertion that it had bought the public utility assets of Silverleaf Resorts, Inc. on August 15, 2005, and that much of the data Algonquin submitted to Staff concerns Silverleaf, rather than Algonquin. However, Algonquin alleges that there is no lawful basis upon which to grant Staff's motion to dismiss due to Algonquin's purchase of Silverleaf. In addition, Algonquin does not object to Staff's request to modify the procedural schedule.

The Commission finds Staff's request to modify the procedural schedule reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The procedural schedule is modified to allow other parties to file direct testimony on revenue requirement no later than December 1, 2006, and to allow other parties to file class cost of service and rate design testimony no later than December 11, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on November 7, 2006.
