**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION TO FILE STAFF'S
RECOMMENDATION**

On May 10, 2022, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed an application seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN), and authority to acquire a water system and sewer system in and around the City of Stewartsville, Missouri, (Stewartsville System) located in DeKalb and Clinton Counties. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) was directed to produce a recommendation, or request an extension of time, on or before June 27, 2022.

On June 24, 2022, Staff filed a request for an extension of time to file its recommendation. Staff requests an extension of 90 days. In support of its request, Staff states it received numerous data request responses, and additional time is needed to review those responses and compile plant calculations. Staff also states it may need to issue further data requests. Staff states it will file its recommendation earlier than the 90-day extension, if possible.

On July 8, 2022, MAWC replied to Staff's request. MAWC recommends an extension of 45 days due to the limited issues and the fact that MAWC would voluntarily expedite responses to data requests to 10 calendar days.¹

The Commission finds Staff's requested extension of 90-days to be reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's request for an extension is granted. Staff shall submit its recommendation on or before September 26, 2022.²
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
