ORDER DIRECTING EXPEDITED RESPONSES TO COMPLIANCE TARIFF

On June 21, 2022, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed an application seeking authority for MAWC to acquire and operate the assets of a water system in and around an area of Benton County, Missouri known as the Pom-Osa Subdivision. On October 10, the Commission issued an order granting MAWC's certificate of convenience and necessity (Order), and directing MAWC to submit compliance tariff sheets to become effective before closing on the assets. On November 16, MAWC filed proposed compliance tariff sheets purporting to be in compliance with the Commission's order, carrying a 30-day effective date of December 16, 2022, and given the Tracking No. YW-2023-0091.

The Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to file an expedited recommendation as to whether the tariff sheets comply with the Commission's Order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. On or before December 2, 2022, Staff shall file a recommendation as directed in the body of this order, or a request for additional time if needed.

2. Any other party wishing to file objections or a recommendation regarding Timber Creek's compliance tariffs shall do so on or before December 2, 2022.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
