**ORDER CANCELING AUTHORITY UNDER CERTIFICATE
AND CANCELING TARIFF**

On November 3, 2010, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order approving the transfer of Loma Linda Water Company's assets to Missouri-American Water Company. Included in the transfer of those assets was Loma Linda's Certificate of Service Authority. Because the Commission has authorized the transfer of Loma Linda's authority to operate as a water company in the state of Missouri, the Commission herein cancels the company's authority as well as its corresponding tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Loma Linda Water Company's authority under its certificate, granted in Commission Case No. WA-92-187, is cancelled.
2. Loma Linda Water Company's tariff, JW-2002-0034, is cancelled.

3. This order shall become effective on May 12, 2011.
4. This case shall be closed on May 13, 2011.
