## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

Issue Date: March 14, 2011 Effective Date: March 14, 2011

On March 9, 2011, the Commission approved Missouri-American Water Company's petition to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") rate schedule to recover ISRS-eligible costs. The Commission approved an ISRS amount that differed from the amount Missouri-American had proposed. As a result, the tariff Missouri-American had previously filed was made incorrect so the Commission rejected that tariff. In its order approving the ISRS changes, the Commission authorized Missouri-American to file a new tariff to implement the approved ISRS rates. Missouri-American filed such a tariff on March 11.

Missouri-American's revised ISRS tariff carries an effective date of April 10, but along with its new tariff, Missouri-American filed a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff to become effective on March 21. Before acting on Missouri-American's request, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation indicating whether the submitted tariff complies with the Commission's March 9 order that approved Missouri-American's ISRS request.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Missouri-American Water Company's ISRS tariff (Tariff No. YW-2011-0461) no later than March 17, 2011.
  - 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
