**ORDER CANCELING ROARK WATER & SEWER, INC.'S
CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY**

On April 27, 2011, the Commission granted the Joint Applications of Missouri-American Water Company and Roark Water & Sewer, Inc. to allow Missouri-American to acquire and operate the water and sewer systems previously owned and operated by Roark. On August 2, Missouri-American filed notice indicating that the transfer of assets was completed on July 29. The Commission approved Missouri-American's adoption of Roark's tariffs on August 10.

On August 18, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to clarify its previous orders by explicitly canceling the certificates of service authority previously granted to Roark to provide water and sewer service. Staff explained that since Roark has transferred its assets to Missouri-American and is no longer providing water or sewer service, its certificates should be canceled. More than ten days have passed since Staff filed its motion and no party has responded to that motion.

The Commission finds that Staff is correct; Roark's certificates of service authority are no longer needed and should be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificates of service authority to provide water and sewer service previously issued by the Commission to Roark Water & Sewer, Inc. are canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on August 30, 2011.
3. This case shall be closed on August 31, 2011.
