ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

Effective Date: April 30, 2013

On April 1, 2013¹, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) asked that the Commission approve its agreement with the Chariton County Public Water Supply District (“District”). That agreement would allow Missouri-American to sell and deliver water to District. In addition, MAWC filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of May 1, 2013.

The Commission issued notice on April 2, and AG Processing, Inc. filed a timely application to intervene. No party objected, and the Commission granted AGP intervention.

On April 25, the Staff of the Commission moved the Commission to suspend the tariff. Staff states that it will be able to file a Recommendation on May 13. Staff moves the Commission to suspend the tariff for 30 days.

Because the Recommendation will not arrive before the effective date for the tariff, the Commission shall suspend the tariff.


