## ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR OBJECTIONS TO TARIFF OR REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

On February 25, 2014, Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") filed a petition to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge. On February 26<sup>th</sup>, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order which suspended the tariff (Tracking No. YW-2014-0329), directed the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation, and set a deadline for interested parties to intervene. No requests to intervene were received. On April 23<sup>rd</sup>, Staff filed its recommendation, to which MAWC filed a response on April 29<sup>th</sup>. On May 22<sup>nd</sup>, MAWC submitted a revised tariff sheet (Tracking No. YW-2014-0472) and a Stipulation and Agreement between MAWC and Staff. MAWC also requested expedited treatment so that the revised tariff sheet may go into effect on May 30<sup>th</sup>. MAWC indicates that both Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel do not object to the request for expedited treatment.

The Commission will set a deadline for parties to file objections to MAWC's request for expedited treatment or the revised tariff sheet.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Interested parties may file objections to Missouri-American Water Company's revised Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge tariff sheet (Tracking No. YW-2014-0472) or the request for expedited treatment no later than May 23, 2014.
  - 2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
