Dear Mr. Downing:

The Public Service Commission proposes to rescind 4 CSR 240-4.020, Ex Parte and Extra-Record Communications. This rescission will rescind the existing rule and will be replaced with six new rules relating to ex parte and extra-record communications.

Adopting the proposed rescission does not implicate the takings clause of the U.S. Constitution, because the proposed rescission does not involve the taking of real property.

The Commission has performed the small business analysis required by Section 536.300, RSMo Supp. 2013, and includes the small business impact statement with this filing. Proposed Rescission to 4 CSR 240-4.020 does not impose any requirement that "will cause direct and significant economic burden upon a small business, or that is directly related to the formation, operation, or expansion of a small business." PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded and replaced with six new rules relating to ex parte and extra-record communications.
