SUPPLEMENT TO MOTION TO ACCEPT LATE-FILED EXHIBIT

COMES NOW, the Office of Public Counsel (Public Counsel), and respectfully advises the Missouri Public Service Commission that some of the letters included within the late-filed exhibit submitted by Public Counsel in this case are letters sent to the Office of the General Counsel of the Public Service Commission (General Counsel). Persons who also sent letters to Public Counsel sent some of the letters to General Counsel. Although an effort was made to avoid duplication, it appears that approximately nine (9) of the seventeen (17) letters included in the late-filed exhibit are substantially similar to letters previously filed in Exhibit #17, and authored by the same persons. The primary difference is that the letters are addressed, in one instance, to Public Counsel, and in the other instance, to the General Counsel. For letters presented to the Commission prior to the hearing, Public Counsel consciously endeavored to avoid duplication where the same party sent letters to both Public Counsel and General Counsel. As a result, duplicate letters were not submitted in Exhibits 16, 17, and 18. Prior to filing the Late-Filed Exhibit, the letters were compared to Exhibits 16 and 18, but not Exhibit 17, due to computer error.

This motion is made for the reason that, in the event any party was attempting to count the letters in the exhibits as a way to estimate the number of persons affected by the Commission's pending decision, there is the risk of some double counting. Public Counsel is aware that more than one person within a household may have written a letter expressing an opinion regarding the outcome of this matter, but considers such freedom of expression to be expected in a free society.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth in the Motion to Accept Late-Filed Exhibit, it is respectfully requested that the Exhibit be accepted by the Commission, with the understanding that in a few instances, Public Counsel did not completely screen out duplicate letters sent to both counsel's offices.
