## ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

Effective Date: November 30, 2005

On November 29, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file a recommendation regarding the joint application for approval of a territorial agreement filed by Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Clark County, Missouri, and the City of Canton, Missouri. The Commission had ordered Staff to file its recommendation by November 29. Staff's motion asks that it be allowed until December 9 to file either a recommendation or a unanimous stipulation and agreement. Staff also asks that it be relieved of the obligation to file a separate recommendation if it instead files a unanimous stipulation and agreement.

Staff's motion is reasonable and will be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Request for Extension of Time is granted.
2. That no later than December 9, 2005, the Staff of the Commission shall file its

recommendation regarding the joint application of Consolidated Public Water Supply

District No. 1 of Clark County, Missouri, and the City of Canton, Missouri, for approval of a territorial agreement.

3. That if the parties file a unanimous stipulation and agreement no later than December 9, 2005, Staff need not file a recommendation regarding the joint application.

4. That this order shall become effective on November 30, 2005.
