On November 29, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file a recommendation regarding the joint application for approval of a territorial agreement filed by Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Clark County, Missouri, and the City of Canton, Missouri. The Commission had ordered Staff to file its recommendation by November 29. Staff's motion asks that it be allowed until December 9 to file either a recommendation or a unanimous stipulation and agreement. Staff also asks that it be relieved of the obligation to file a separate recommendation if it instead files a unanimous stipulation and agreement.

- 3. That if the parties file a unanimous stipulation and agreement no later than December 9, 2005, Staff need not file a recommendation regarding the joint application.
